

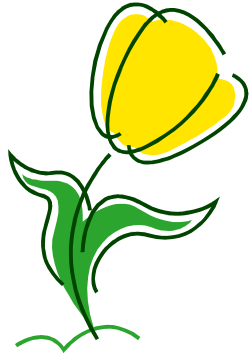

Commercial water users may be able to save time and money by having all backflow prevention devices (such as fire and domestic) tested this spring when the irrigation system is turned on. TRASH UPDATES

We receive many calls about trash and yard waste pickup. To ensure waste is picked up each week, be sure to place it at the curb **by 6:00am** on your specific day. Also note that each type of waste, whether it be regular, recycling or yard waste needs to be placed only in it's specific container. A reminder that residents must subscribe for yard waste pickup. This is an additional charge. If you called to cancel pickup then you need to sign up again. Call Public Works at 636-327-5102.

UTILITY TAX REFUNDS

Beginning April 1 through May 31 residents 65 years old or considered totally disabled may be eligible for a refund of city tax paid on electric, gas and phone bills during 2010. Maximum gross income is \$38,300 for single households or \$43,750 for married. For more information call City Hall at (636) 327-5101.
