SUMMER JOB FAIR

Are you looking to earn a little extra cash this summer? The Parks and Recreation department is seeking individuals to fill temporary summer positions. Lifeguards, Concessionaires, Day Camp Counselors and Umpires are needed. Plan on attending the Job Fair to be held on Thursday, March 8 from 2:00-7:00pm at Progress Park. All applicants are required to be age 16 by May 1, 2012. Starting pay varies depending on the position and experience. Applicants should be prepared to be interviewed at that time. YARD WASTE PICKUP RESUMES

Yard waste pickup for residents resumes the first week of March and continues through the last week of December. Residents receiving the service last December will automatically renew in March. Those who do not wish to renew need to cancel by February 29, 2012. Residents wishing to add the service can do so by contacting Public Works at (636) 639-2049. Subscribers to this service please note that it is only available for the entire season (March-December) and may not be cancelled during the year. One-time pickups are available for a charge of \$3.50 per bag. Yard waste is collected on the same day as normal trash pickup and should be placed at the curb by 6:00am.
