- Christmas Day

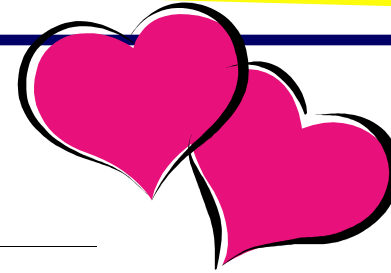
