BACKFLOW TESTS **DUE JUNE 1**

Wentzville requires all Irrigation Backflow Prevention Devices to be tested by a State Certified Backflow Tester. Test results need to be sent to 200 E Fourth St., Wentzville, MO 63385 or fax to (636) 327-4892. If reports are not received by June 1st then accounts are subject to late fees and water service disconnection.

YARD WASTE PICKUP

Residents subscribing to this service are reminded that containers need to be clearly marked "YARD WASTE" if providing their own containers. Yard waste stickers are available through Public Works. Also note that leaves and grass clippings are the only items included in yard waste.

All containers, including trash, recycling and yard waste should be placed at the curb by 6am.

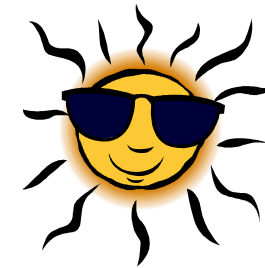
