## PROJECT PARKS UPDATE

In September 2011, the City entered into a contract for the planning and design of Project Parks with a multi-disciplinary design team led by Planning Design Studio, a St. Louis based landscape architecture firm with significant experience in project management and the design of recreation facilities. Planning and design activities are underway and will include input from working committees, community input sessions and public presentations. Public presentations for Peruque Valley Park, Heartland Park and Splash Station Aquatic Center will be held on **December 20, 2011, 6:30pm at Progress Park Center, 968 Meyer Road.**
