Paper & Cardboard

Everything that tears:

- | | |
|--------------|-------------------|
| Newspaper | Magazines |
| Mail | Envelopes |
| Phone books | Paperback books |
| File folders | Soda cases |
| Office paper | Paper egg cartons |

- Flattened Boxes (pizza, cereal, cake, etc.)
- Notebooks (no metal clips, spirals, or binders)
- Gable-top milk & juice cartons
- Gift wrap (no foil wrapping)

Do not include:

| Waxy paper | | Newspaper sleeves |
| Items with food | | Plates or napkins |
| Toilet paper/tissues | | Pet-soiled paper |

Metal

Aluminum, steel & tin:

| Foil | Trays |
| Cans | Jar lids |

Empty, non-hazardous aerosol cans (cooking oil, whipped cream)

Do not include:

- Large metal
- Metal with food or other material

Glass

Clear, brown, and green (empty & rinse)

Do not include:

| Windows | | Light bulbs |
| Pyrex | | Dinnerware |
| Mirrors | | Ceramics |

Plastic

Buckets (up to 5 gallons)

Containers & lids (empty & rinse):

- Soda, water bottles, etc.
- Milk & juice jugs, detergent, etc.
- Narrow neck only
- Butter tubs, six pack rings, etc.
- Yogurt cups, syrup, ketchup, etc.
- Narrow neck only

Do not include:

- | | | |

| Styrofoam | | Wrap or film |
| Diapers | | Packing peanuts |
| Plastic bags | | Tarps or sheets |
| Hazardous chemical containers (such as oil, pesticides, etc.) | | |

Instructions:

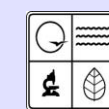
1. Empty and/or rinse clean (if needed).
2. Mix all recyclables together—no sorting necessary!
3. Place at the curb with the lid closed.

Remember:

- Do not bag recyclables.
- No food, yard waste, diapers, pet litter, hot ashes or wood.
- It makes sense to recycle! It creates jobs and saves energy and natural resources.
