In accordance with the Citizen Participation Plan, notice is hereby given that the County of St. Charles, Missouri, is in the process of updating the Citizen Participation Plan and preparing its FY18 Annual Action Plan for the Community Development Block Grant Program funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. The St. Charles County Department of Community Development will hold a public hearing to solicit citizen comments on citizen participation, housing, community development, and public service needs, including priority non-housing community needs, and proposed activities for funding for unincorporated St. Charles County, and the participating jurisdictions of Cottleville, Lake St. Louis, New Melle, St. Peters, St Charles, St. Paul, Weldon Spring and Wentzville.
