

DO YOU NEED A RIDE TO SHOPPING AND MEDICAL APPOINTMENTS?

The St. Charles County Transportation Program provides transportation to eligible residents of *unincorporated* St. Charles County, Cottleville, Dardenne Prairie, Lake St. Louis, St. Paul, St. Peters, Weldon Spring and Wentzville for necessary medical, shopping and other essential services. A limited number of trips for each selected applicant will be made available. Transportation for essential shopping and other services are limited to locations within St. Charles County. Trips for medical purposes are limited to 15 miles from home.

To be eligible, you must:

- Reside within the participating jurisdictions
- Lack access to a vehicle or be unable to drive
- Be at least 62 years of age **OR** be severely disabled **OR** be low-moderate income as established by U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development guidelines. The 50% figures are considered very low income. The below table lists 2014 income limits based upon 2013 Income Tax Returns.

Transportation services will be available Monday-Saturday from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m.
