Candidates may file for the elected municipal offices that will appear on the April 2016 ballot until 5 p.m. on Tuesday, Jan. 19. Candidates will need to file at City Hall, located at 310 W. Pearce Blvd.

Positions open for filing include one Alderman from each of the three Wards, as well as the Mayor. The Alderman positions are for two-year terms; the Mayor's position is a four-year term.

City ordinances state that candidates running for Alderman must be at least 18 years of age; a citizen of the United States; and an inhabitant and resident of the City for at least one year prior to the election. Candidates running for Alderman must also be a resident, at the time he/she files and during the time he/she serves, of the Ward from which he/she is elected.

City ordinances state that candidates running for Mayor must be at least 25 years of age; a citizen of the United States; and a resident of the City at the time of, and at least one year prior to, the election.
